3 IMAGES FROM ONE MEMBER

01 - March on City Hall - Carmel Citizens Come Marching In.jpg

Interesting capture, has potential but the oversaturation distracts from the image. Catchy title is not an informative caption. Why are the citizens marching? Who is the bagpiper?

02 - March on City Hall - Carmel Citizens Take to the Streets.jpg

The image does a good job showing the density of the small crowded street. The sign gives the viewer some idea of what is happening and the small view of the city hall sign helps us with the location.

Unfortunately the caption tells us little about why they have taken to the streets and just who "Jason" is.

03 - March on City Hall - Mayor Trying to Explain What Went Wrong.jpg

The framing shows the crowd and calls our attention to the central discussion. However, a photojournalist, unless he has clear evidence elsewhere, must not presume to know what the discussion is about. Instead of "trying to explain," which is presumptuous, you might have simply said "Mayor XXX, seen here in the right center, holds conversation with several Carmel residents in front of City Hall."

With only three entries, only one award is given.
