


Opened up shadows on the peak.... brings more color ... more Fall to balance the image Cropped to rule of thirds and a bit less sky.





Cropped and adjusted shadows. Got rid of white dot/light on far left shore.








If there ever was a good argument to allow some image manipulation, this is it. Once you see those God awful TV antenas they are hard/impossible to un-see.

Lightened shadows ... added 15% green photo filter ... cropped to rule of 1/3rds ... smart sharpen to 50%





Quite a building Next time I'm in KC I will try to stop in.











...or go with B/W?






08 - Entrance to the City, Valencia, Spain.jpg



Technically very nice, but I am not certain how that translates into the category of "travel".






