


Beautiful so quiet and serene. I hope that you also got a chance to just sit in one of those chairs and "soak-it-all-in".

I did a bit of shadow adjustment and a bit of sharpening to bring out the koala coat.






05-Late Afternoon in Prague.jpg *Denice Loria Woyski*



Very nice.






11-Saint Lawrence Seaway Lock- Quebec Canada.jpg Ken Jones
